Applicants must have:

Animal handling and program training will be provided. Programmers may work 5 to 20 hours per week and must be available on a part-time basis weekdays, weekends and some evenings April 15 through mid-August. Schedule may include some holidays.

Positions above are paid on an hourly rate based on experience. Applicants for all positions must be:

- At least 18 years of age
- Able to lift 50 lbs.

College students and teachers are encouraged to apply. Hiring is dependent on proof of a negative TB (ppd) test within the last 12 months and a valid NYS driver's license.
